SEMINAR ON INNOVATIONS IN PHARMACEUTICAL RESEARCH-2016 & ORAL PRESENTATIONS and 4th INDO-WESTINDIES CONFERENCE

International seminar on "Innovations in Pharmaceutical Research 2016 and Oral Presentations" and "4th Indo-West Indies conference" was organized by G. Pulla Reddy College of Pharmacy, Mehdipatnam, Hyderabad in association with Association of Pharmacy Professionals Telangana state branch on July 30th 2016. The program was inaugurated by the chief guest Prof. R Shyam Sunder, Dean, Faculty of Pharmacy & Professor, chemical engineering, University College of Technology, Osmania University, Hyderabad and speakers of the seminar were Dr. K. GUEST LECTURES

He discussed various aspects of physiological based modeling techniques and demonstrated the evaluation of computer simulated pharmacokinetic properties of novel agents using simCYP Software. 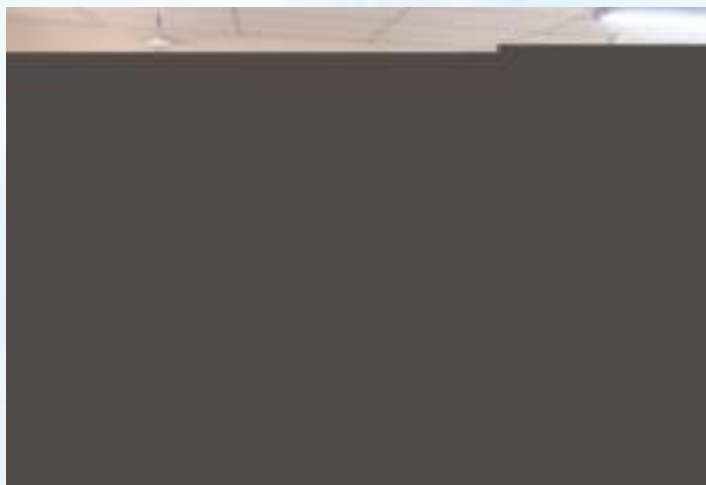
