SEMINAR ON INNOVATIONS IN PHARMACEUTICAL RESEARCH AND ORAL PRESENTATIONS

A one day seminar on "Innovations in Pharmaceutical Research and Oral Presentations" was organized in Association with Indian Pharmaceutical Association, Telangana State Branch on 19th August, 2017. The seminar was aimed to provide knowledge on "Recent Developments in Pharmaceutical Research" to undergraduate and postgraduate students. Total 366 delegates registered for the seminar and 97 papers were presented in various Scientific Sessions. The program was Inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Dr. D. Rambhau, Director-Technical, Pulse Advance Research Centre, Hyderabad. Guest of Honor, Mr. S.B.M.P. Halakatti, Vice President-Quality Assurance and Quality Control, Hetero Drugs Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad and Dr. B. Prabha Shankar, President, IPA Telangana State Branch, Managing Director, Euro Drugs India Ltd., Hyderabad, shared the dias and the seminar was presided by Dr. B. Madhava Reddy, Principal and he welcomed the gathering and briefed the objectives of the seminar. Dr. B. Prabha Shankar, in his talk enlightened upon the real meaning of research and innovation with practical examples in pharmaceutical field. Scientific Abstract Book was released on this occasion by the dignitaries on the dias.

Mr. S.B.M.P. Halakatti delivered a lecture on "Beginning and Evolution of cGMP and Regulations". He discussed about the evolution of GMP citing various instances; applicability of Current Good Manufacturing Practice (cGMP) to quality assurance and for various regulatory compliances (WHO, USFDA, EMEA and Health Canada). Dr. D. Rambhau delivered keynote address on "Drug Discovery in India: A Myth or a Reality". He has given very interesting information on the status of innovations in our country and impact of drug delivery systems after 2020, when many patents are expiring, the requirement of nanotechnology in drug delivery. Participants had good interaction with speakers and clarified their doubts. Dr. B. Madhava Reddy, Principal presented mementos to the speakers.



In the afternoon session, students from various colleges presented Oral Scientific Papers in various aspects of Pharmaceutical Research and Development. The presentations were evaluated by the senior faculty and 10 Best Oral Presentations were selected. In the evening Valedictory Programme was conducted. Merit Certificates and Mementos were presented to the winners of Oral Presentation competition by the Principal and Professors of various departments. The programme was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. D. Prashanthi.
