

#### 1. General Rules of Admission

- In G. Pulla Reddy College of Pharmacy B.pharmacy, M.pharmacy and Pharm.D courses are
  offered.
- The admissions are done as per the general admissions rules of Telangana State government in vogue.
- There are two kinds of admission streams
  - i) Convener (Category -A)
  - ii) Management (Category -B)

#### For B.pharmacy/ Pharm.D courses:

- The basic eligibility to the admission into B.pharm/Pharm.D is intermediate /10+2 with [M.P.C] or [Bi.P.C]
- The minimum % at 10+2 or intermediate as per state government rules announced from time to time.
- The Convener admissions are done by WEB option Counselling method based on Rank in EAMCET. The reservation rules are applicable as per state government rules.
- The management quota admissions are done by management by following the general rules of the merit in EAMCET/ Intermediate / 10+2 and other rules as specified by the state government.

#### For M.pharm courses:

- The basic eligibility for admission to M.pharm is B.pharm.
- The Convener admissions are done by WEB option Counselling method based on rank in GPAT/PGECET. The reservation rules are applicable as per state government rules.
- The management quota admissions are done by management by the following the general rules
  of the merit at GPAT/PGECET/B.pharm and other rules are specified by the state government.

### 5. Examination

- The B.Pharm course is 4 years and split into 8 semesters
- The Pharm.D course is 6 years (No semester)
- The M.pharm course is 2 years and split into 4 semesters
- The students have to appear for Sessional examinations as per the dates announced by the college and candidate will be allowed to Sessional examinations based on his/her attendance/ payment of tuition or other fee.
- The examination pattern for the theory and practical will be as per course rules and regulations.
- The minimum pass marks/grades in each subject and in each semester, promotion to next higher semester, as per the course rules and regulations prescribed by the university/PCI.

# 6. Library

- The college has an excellent library facility with information center located in the second floor.
   The library is well equipped with modern facilities with resources in the form of online databases, books, journals, back volumes of Journals, M.Pharm/Ph.D thesis books, E-books and Internet & print/xerox facility.
- Library & Information centre is equipped with sufficient number of volumes covering all the subjects like Ph.Chemistry, Pharmacognosy, Pharmacology, Pharmaceutics, Pharm. Analysis and general books etc.
- The working hours of the library are from 9 AM to 5 PM.
   Students have open access to any text book during library hours.
   NOTE: Each student will be given 5 library cards per semester He/She can avail 5 text books for the semester.

## 7. Campus placements
