PHARMACY COURSE

Pharmacy is a professional course which gives an overall and in depth knowledge of drugs. This course imparts the knowledge of preparation of drugs, their actions, side effects, toxicity, formulation of the drugs into various dosage forms such as tablets, injections, syrups etc., and monitoring their actions in patients.

B. Pharm is a four year degree course, which is pharmaceutical technology oriented and encompasses the knowledge and training for synthesis, analysis, pharmacology of drugs and formulation development of various dosage forms.

M. Pharm is a two year post graduate course in various specializations. This course gives an advanced knowledge and research methodology for the drug discovery and development.

Pharm. D is a six year Doctor of pharmacy course, which is equivalent to post graduation in pharmacy. This course is clinical and hospital oriented. It encompasses the knowledge and training on drugs uses, actions, adverse reactions, clinical research and pharmacotherapeutic outcome.
